Wheat Beer

is a pale, unfiltered version, using an equal blend of malted wheat and barley. Top fermenting yeast imparts a mild character, while the beer is hopped in the kettle with "Perle", and "Strisselspalt" for aroma leaving the beer unfiltered enhances mouthfeel and allows the subtle malt flavor to come through.

Southern Hemisphere Harvest

Ruthless Hefeweizen

This ale is fermented with a special wheat beer yeast which imparts a clove-like spiciness with vanilla or nutmeg notes and a fruitiness reminiscent of bananas or apples. Low in bitterness and mildly tart with a soft roundness characteristic of a hefeweizen. This ale is unfiltered, pale in color, and cloudy
